Voter proposal would end electricity monopolies and create choice

TALLAHASSEE — Members of the Constitution Revision Commission will vote Friday on whether to allow Floridians to vote on being able to choose their electricity provider, effectively dismantling the monopoly utilities who control electricity generation and transmission in the state.
