## **DOE Distribution Transformers Proposed Rule**

On January 11, 2023, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) published a proposed rule to amend energy conservation standards for distribution transformers. The proposed rule impacts three categories of distribution transformers and requires that these products use amorphous steel cores as opposed to the current cores, among other requirements. Written comments on the proposed rule are due by March 27, 2023.
