RE: Access to Restoration Areas During Emergency Recovery Operations

In the event of a natural disaster or emergency, it is essential that natural gas and electric utilities be given access to their infrastructure to ensure expedient repairs and safety.

If a natural disaster has occurred or if emergency conditions exist:

It is requested that natural gas and electric utilities be granted access to the areas where restoration efforts are needed. They will be delivering/receiving materials necessary for the repair and restoration of the natural gas and electric infrastructure. Included in this request is any truck or shipping company that the utilities have contracted to deliver their products and services, please grant access to the areas where restoration efforts are in effect.

NOTE: The contracted trucking or shipping companies will produce a document from the natural gas or electric utilities identifying them as a sub-supplier and authorizing them to deliver restoration supplies for the utility.
