## Draft Definition

In order to effectively respond to any emergency that threatens the critical infrastructure of our state and to maintain/restore critical infrastructure such as power to any affected area, Florida Electric Utility personnel and associated support will be recognized as "related services as defined in HSPD 8" that is necessary to support restoration of the power infrastructure essential to the nation's security, public health, safety, economic vitality, and way of life; and will therefore upon presentation of official organization identification from a Florida Electric Utility provider be granted the same considerations and access to affected areas as first responders.
