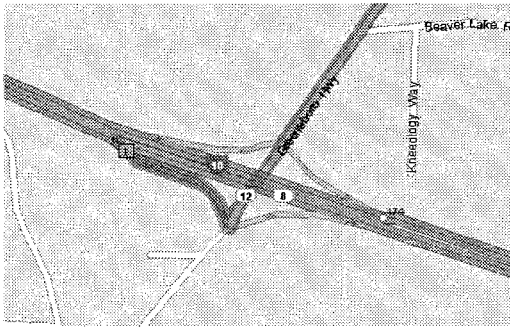

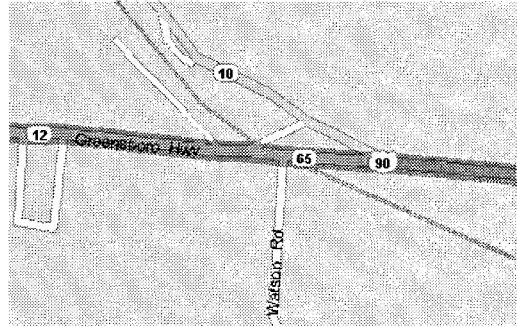

Turn left into Talquin Electric's Operations center at first driveway on Mainline Drive - 0.1 Miles

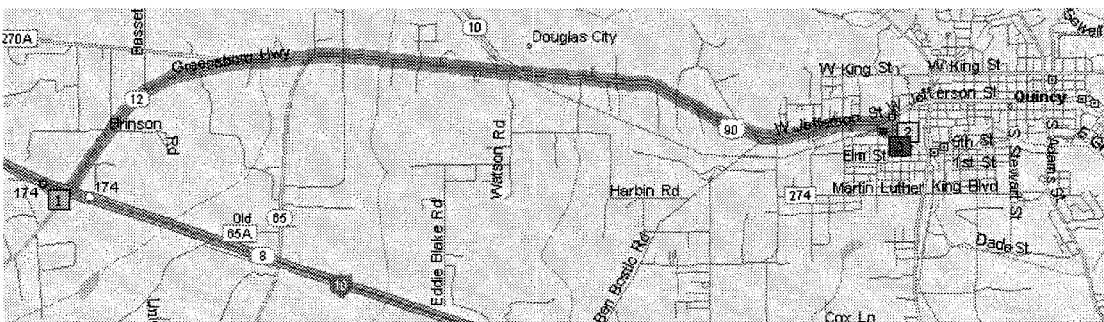
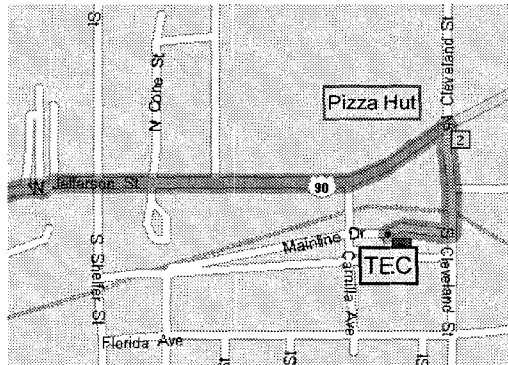
