LOCATION OF WINDY POINT STAGING AREA

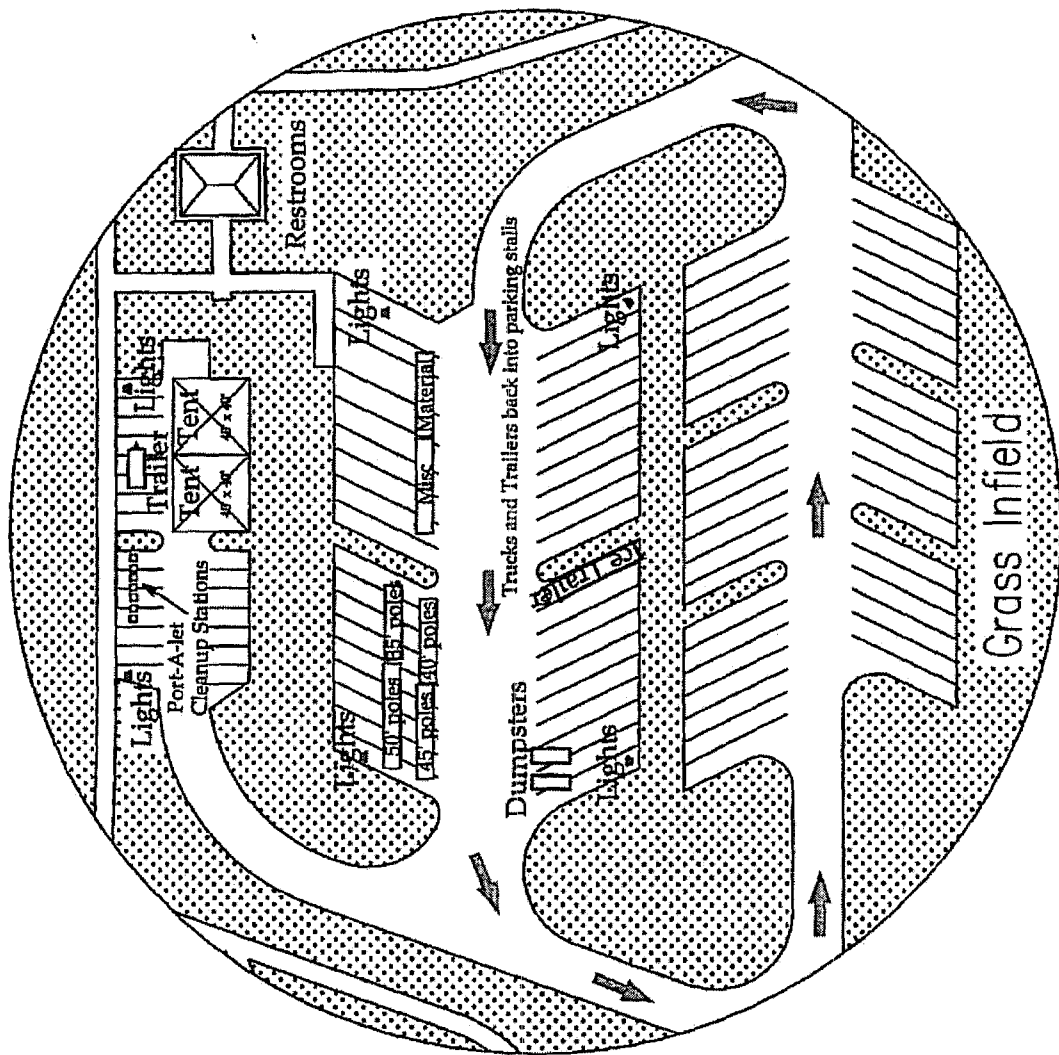

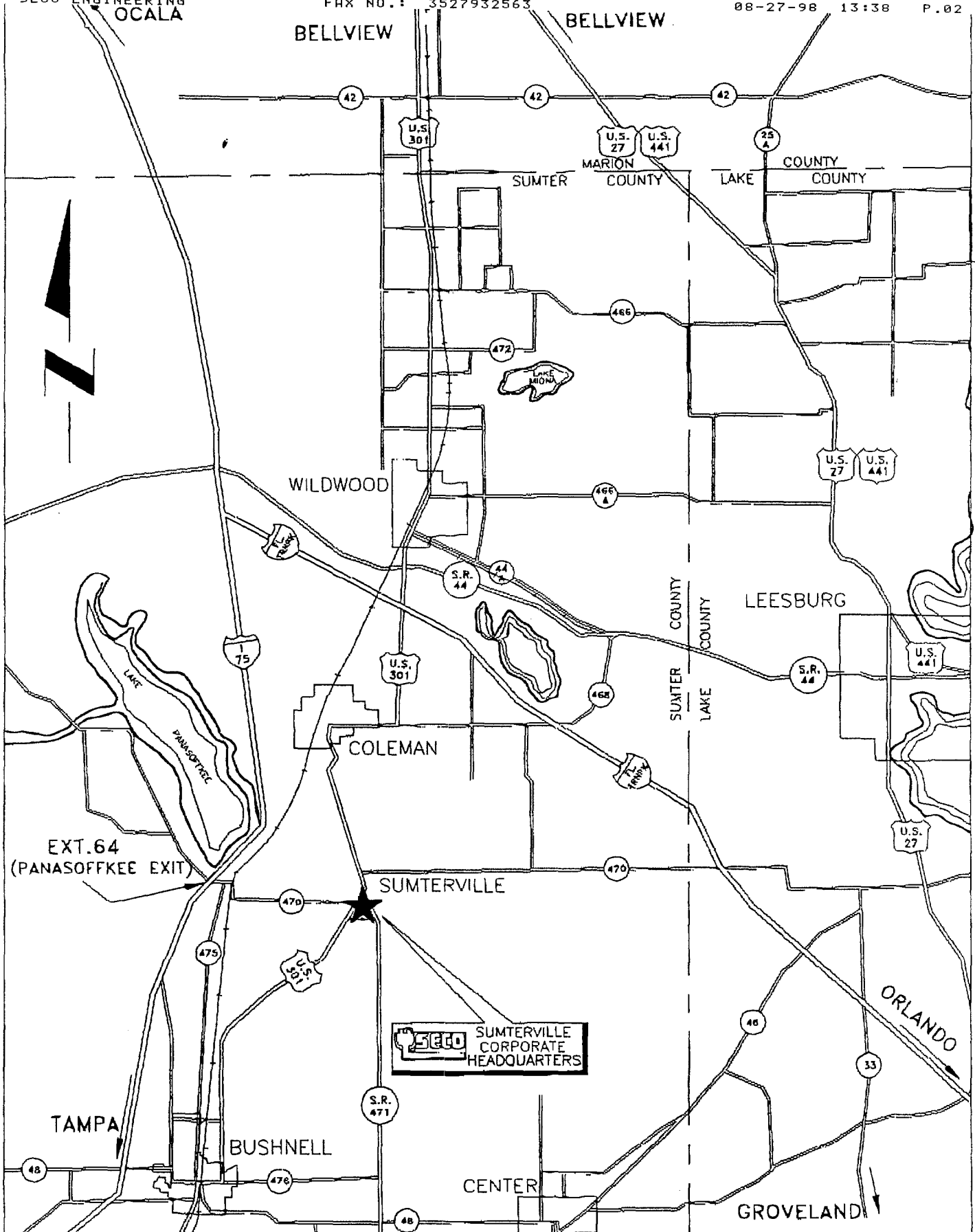

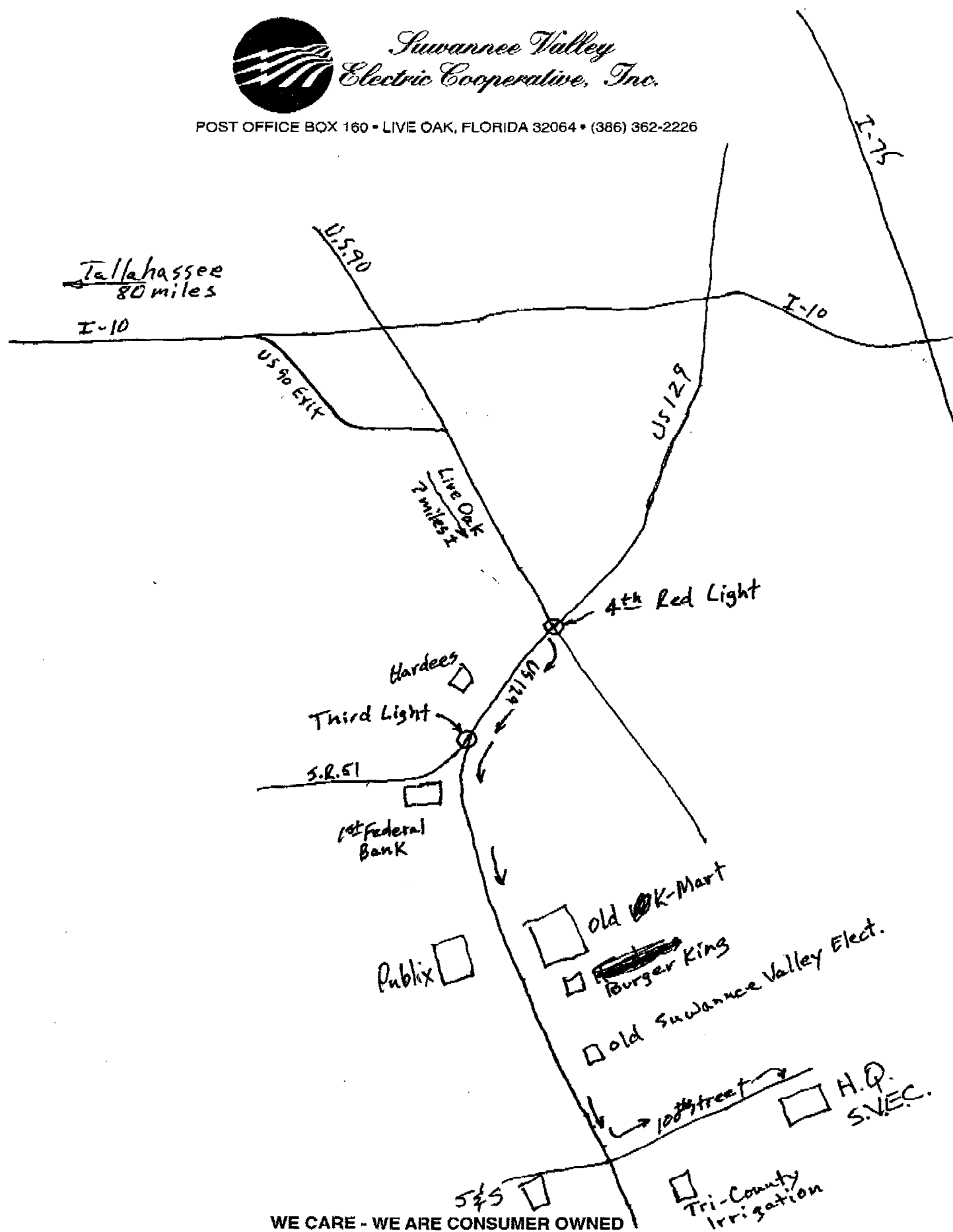
